**WISE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT MEETING**

On this the 12<sup>th</sup> day of September, A.D., 2022 at 8:45 AM came on to be had a Public Hearing of the Commissioners' Court of Wise County, Texas held in the County Court at Law Court Room (3<sup>rd</sup>) Floor in County Courthouse of said County in the town of Decatur with the following members present and presiding:

County Judge Clark votes aye on all agenda items unless otherwise indicated.

Clark opened the public hearing at 8:45 AM, all court members were present.

Clark stated the purpose of this public hearing is for public discussion of the proposed Wise County budget; Wise County tax rates; and Weatherford College Branch Campus Maintenance Tax for Fiscal Year 2023 (being October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023). Clark noted the three-minute time limit for public comment; and, that any changes or action to the FY2023 proposed budget will be considered during the meeting that follows this public hearing.

Precinct No. 3 resident Lee Worley addressed the court requesting a reduced property tax; maximum rates allowed by law; and nationwide inflation. Worley expressed his concerns about the proposed tax rate and requested the court consider no new revenue taxes.

No other public comments were made to the court.

Clark closed the public hearing at 8:55 AM there being no further comments to be had by the public.

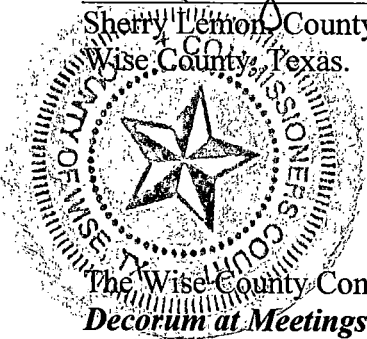
